

Uniforms/Free Dress

Parents/Guardians are responsible for seeing that their students are dressed appropriately and according to the Uniform Policy and Dress Code. Holy Rosary School reserves the right to send home students who are not in compliance with these policies. Parents/guardians will be notified and are expected to remedy the situation immediately.

Pre-kindergarten students are not required to wear the Holy Rosary School uniform. Please refer to the Pre-kindergarten Handbook for further information.

1. Boys' Uniform

- Navy blue cord (thin wale only) or twill pant. ***NAME BRAND SHOULD BE REMOVED if purchased outside the uniform company.*** A belt must be worn (solid navy blue, black, or dark brown).
- Navy blue twill walk short. ***NAME BRAND SHOULD BE REMOVED if purchased outside the uniform company.*** A belt must be worn (solid navy blue, black, or dark brown).
- White knit polo shirt (short or long sleeve) with no logo.
- White knit polo shirt *with Holy Rosary School logo* (short or long sleeve) from the **uniform company only.**
- Navy blue knit polo shirt *with Holy Rosary School logo* (short sleeve, grades K-8) from the **uniform company only.**
- White turtleneck shirt (long sleeve) with no logo.
- Navy blue sweatshirt *with Holy Rosary School logo* from the **uniform company only.**
- Navy blue v-neck cardigan sweater (grades K-5 only) from the **uniform company only.**
- Navy blue v-neck pullover sweater (long sleeve, grades 6-8 only) from the **uniform company only.**
- White and navy blue socks only.

2. Girls' Uniform

- Rampart jumper (grades K-5 only) and rampart skirt (grades 5-8 only) from the **uniform company only.**

- Navy blue twill pant. ***NAME BRAND SHOULD BE REMOVED if purchased outside the uniform company.*** A belt must be worn (solid navy blue, black, or dark brown).
- Navy blue twill walk short. ***NAME BRAND SHOULD BE REMOVED if purchased outside the uniform company.*** A belt must be worn (solid navy blue, black, or dark brown).
- White Peter Pan blouse (short or long sleeve) with buttons in front.
- White knit polo shirt (short or long sleeve) with no logo.
- White knit polo shirt *with Holy Rosary School logo* (short or long sleeve) from the **uniform company only.**
- Navy blue knit polo shirt *with Holy Rosary School logo* (short sleeve, grades K-8) from the **uniform company only.**
- White turtleneck shirt (long sleeve) with no logo.
- Navy blue sweatshirt *with Holy Rosary School logo* from the **uniform company only.**
- Navy blue v-neck cardigan sweater (grades K-5 only) from the **uniform company only.**
- Navy blue v-neck pullover sweater (long sleeve, grades 6-8 only) from the **uniform company only.**
- White and navy blue socks and tights only.

3. Shoes

- Tennis shoes must be a solid color or combination of white, black, dark blue, light blue, or gray. No other colors may be worn. They may be high top or low cut, leather or sturdy canvas, tie or Velcro closures.
- Other shoes must be leather and a solid color of white, black, dark blue, or brown. Oxfords (i.e. black and white, navy blue and white, etc.) are permitted. No checkered shoes or Helly's are allowed. The school has the final interpretation of appropriate shoes. The least distracting is recommended.

- Shoes must be in good condition. Laces must match the basic shoe color. Laces must be tied on top of the shoe so shoes are secure on the feet and shoes cannot be removed or kicked off without untying the laces.
- Slip-on shoes, open-toed shoes, heeled shoes, dress shoes, sandals, wedges, platforms, boots, hiking shoes/boots, multi-colored accents, character logos, flip flops and light-up shoes are not permitted.

4. Hair

- Girls' hair must be neatly groomed and arranged so that it does not impair vision.
- Boys' hair must be neatly groomed in such a way that the hair is cut above the eyebrows and is neatly trimmed above the shirt collar.
- "Mohawks", stripes, or "fashion" haircuts are not permitted for girls or boys. If in doubt about a certain hairstyle, ask to see if it will be appropriate before the hair is cut.
- **Hair spray, coloring, dying, highlighting, bleaching, etc. is not permitted.**

5. General

- All clothing must be of appropriate size, length, and style. **Items for which it is permissible to purchase outside of the uniform company should match the regulation uniform item.**
- Shirttails must be tucked in at all times.
- Shirts must be sufficient length to cover the waist. No shirt of any kind is allowed under the polo. The "layered" look is not permitted.
- A plain black, navy blue, or brown belt must be worn at all times with shorts and pants.
- Socks must cover the ankle and be visible above the shoe. Socks may not be tucked into the shoes.
- Leggings or nylons are not permitted.
- Hats are not permitted.
- One small, post earring is allowed in lower ear lobe only. Dangling or hoop earrings are not permitted.

- Fingernail polish, false nails, or make-up are not permitted.
- Anything that distracts from learning (noisy bracelets, watches, etc.) is not permitted.
- Jumpers and skirts must be knee length (no more than two (2) inches above the knee but not below the knee). Skirts may not be rolled at the waist.
- Shorts must be knee length (no more than two (2) inches above the knee but not below the knee). Shorts and pants may not be baggy (i.e. waistline hanging at hips, pants bagging at the ankles). Pants may not be pegged, rolled, pinned, or tucked.
- Shorts (no longer than two (2) inches above the hemline) must be worn under the uniform jumper or uniform skirt at all times.
- Field Day, A's, & Choir t-shirts may be worn with the twill pant, cord pant, or twill walk short only on Wednesday.
- Caritas Creek and Eighth Grade sweatshirts may be worn.
- Scout uniforms may be worn on scout meeting days.
- Non-uniform jackets may be worn ***OUTDOORS ONLY AND ONLY OVER*** the uniform sweatshirt, uniform sweater, Caritas Creek sweatshirt, or Eighth Grade sweatshirt. Non-uniform jackets and non-uniform sweatshirts ***MAY NOT BE WORN INDOORS***. **Non-uniform sweatshirts and jackets include C.Y.O. team, cheerleading, college or university, etc.**
- All uniforms should be free of any tears, rips, etc. . .
- **All students in grades 6 – 8 must use a rolling backpack.**

6. Free Dress

Clothing must be modest and appropriate for school. **Free dress does not change the policy on Shoes, Hair, and General items listed previously.**

- a) Students **may** wear the following:
- Jeans, corduroy pants, or dress pants.
 - Dresses or skirts must be no shorter than two inches above the knee.
 - School uniform walk shorts only.

- Shirts designed for sports wear.

b) Students **may not** wear the following:

- Clothing with inappropriate slogans, words, or decoration.
- Clothing that is ragged, fringed, patched, faded, torn, or ripped.
- Backless, strapless, spaghetti strap, sleeveless, tank, or sun dresses.
- Backless, strapless, spaghetti strap, sleeveless, or tank tops.
- Leggings, warm up pants, warm-up suits, sweatpants, pajama style bottoms, or cut-offs.
- Spandex.
- Skirts that are shorter than two inches above the knees.
