

eScrip and Safeway Club Card

These instructions will cover three topics:

- 1) How to get a Safeway Club Card.
- 2) How to register it for Holy Rosary School.
- 3) How to verify that credit is going to Holy Rosary School.
- 4) Miscellaneous information

How to get a Safeway Club Card

To get a Safeway Club Card card go to: www.safeway.com

At the bottom right of the screen click on “Safeway”

Click on the red tab that says “Save”

On the left side of the screen click on “ClubCard Savings”.

On the left side of the screen click on “ClubCard Application”

Print out the application. Fill it out and turn it in at the cashier at your local Safeway. You will get your card and savings on the spot.

Remember to get the maximum savings be sure to tell your family and friends to give your phone number or Savings Card number when they buy anything at Safeway. Not only will they save when they buy, but you will earn credits at the school. Some families are averaging \$10 to \$20 per month.

How to register it for Holy Rosary school

- Go into website www.escrip.com
- Choose selection #1 “Sign up-It’s free”
- Where the screen asks you to “**Search to see if your group is enrolled with the program**” type in “Holy Rosary School”
- Scroll down to Holy Rosary School in Antioch, CA, and click on the name
- Click “Next” to proceed to the next step
- Complete the fields on the screen, then click “Next”
- Register your Safeway card number, then click “Next”
- Register the Safeway card number of your friends and extended family.
- Register your credit/debit card(s) – Visa, MC, AmEx, Discover, ATM, and Diners Club are eligible. Click “Next” when done.
- Register your retail credit card(s) – Macy’s and Office Max are eligible. Click “Next” when done.
- Confirm information on page. Edit if needed. Click “Confirm” button when done.
- Click on “Create Your Personal Password” to create a password. You will use this password, along with the **SUPPORTER ID #** shown on the webpage, for your future use to track your activity, rebates, etc., when you logon to the escrip webpage.

Safeway Tiered Contribution Structure

1% on monthly purchases up to \$300

2% on monthly purchases between \$300 to \$500

3% on monthly purchases between \$500 to \$600

4% on monthly purchases over \$600

Here's how it works:*If your monthly purchases totaled \$650--*

Up to \$300 1% \$3.00

\$300-\$500 2% \$4.00

\$500 -\$600 3% \$3.00

Over \$600 4% \$2.00

Total Contribution: \$12.00

- **IMPORTANT: You must provide your eScrip ID # to the Holy Rosary School office to receive credit for your eScrip rebates toward your PTG assessment. This is different than your Safeway Club Card number. Fill out the scrip notification form that is available on the school web page and turn it in to the office. How to verify that credit is going to Holy Rosary school

To verify that you are really signed up for Holy Rosary go to: www.escrip.com

On the left side of the screen click on “Sign in to my eScrip to view purchase activity.”

Enter your eScrip ID and password and then login.

Click on “Go to Account Information.”

Under the heading “Group Selection” it should list Holy Rosary School.

To see how much credit you have earned click on “View My Monthly Statement.”

Then pick a time period that you want to see. Remember that reports from school may not show the latest month's data.

Miscellaneous information

Lost cards – Notify Safeway and register your new card with your existing escrip account.

Multiple numbers – We can process up to three escrip accounts, but prefer that you put multiple cards onto one account. No need to notify the school since your Escrip account number has not changed.

DISCLAIMER: Holy Rosary School has no control over the eScrip program and cannot take any responsibility if eScrip decides to alter or discontinue it. Each Holy Rosary family is responsible for their PTG assessment regardless of whether Escrip credits their account or does not credit their account.

NOTE: Many commercial websites routinely change their format, so the above directions may not work exactly as described. If you find that it has changed please notify the escrip coordinator and describe the changes so that it will be correct for the next user.
