SERVICE PROJECT GUIDELINES

- Must be approved by mentor teacher
- Must be supervised by an adult
- Should not be a project that is a normal family responsibility (babysitting, pet sitting, helping the family business)
- May not receive pay for time spent on project
- Project must benefit parish, school community or city. Organization must be a non-profit organization. If you are not sure a project will qualify, contact your mentor.
- Questions to be asked by young adults – Is this project being done with Christian Love?

This form must be completed. Keep in a CSLP binder. Form will be collected at the end of each trimester, along with the Timesheet log.

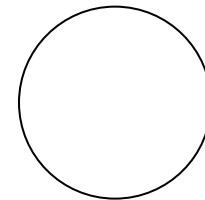
